COMMUNITY POWER COALITION OF NEW HAMPSHIRE COST SHARING AGREEMENT

This Cost Sharing Agreement (“Agreement”) is made and entered into this 3rd day of April, 2023, by and between the Town of Canterbury, a subdivision of the State of New Hampshire, (“the Member”) and the Community Power Coalition of New Hampshire (“CPCNH” or “Corporation”), pursuant to the provisions of the CPCNH Joint Powers Agreement (“JPA”) (collectively, the “Parties”).

1. Authorized Officer. The Member may designate an Authorized Officer to take specific actions, as defined in Section 2: Authorizations below, on behalf of the Member pursuant to this Agreement and the Policies. The Member’s Authorized Officer, as specified in the Member’s Electric Aggregation Plan, or otherwise delegated authority by the governing body hereunder, is:

The Member’s Principal Executive Officer may specify a new Authorized Officer by submitting written notice by electronic mail to CPCNH’s Principal Representative, which shall be promptly acknowledged and effective thereof, and such updates to this Contract shall not be considered an amendment.

2. Authorizations. The Authorized Officer may act on behalf of the Member to instruct and authorize CPCNH only on the matters and to the extent explicitly authorized by the Member hereunder. The Member hereby delegates the following authorities to the Authorized Officer to act on the Member’s behalf (specify “yes” or “no”):

- a) Pursuant to Article VI, Section 3, the Authorized Officer may elect to delay commencing procurement; YES;
- b) Pursuant the Retail Rates Policy, the Authorized Officer may specify default and optional products: ~~YES~~^{NO}; and
- c) Pursuant the Retail Rates Policy, the Authorized Officer may set Discretionary Reserve adders: ~~YES~~^{NO}.

Whereas, the Board has considered several options for Canterbury Community Power default energy service rates for the upcoming six-month period August 1, 2025—January 31, 2026. ¶

Now therefore, be it resolved that the new community power default energy service rate for the upcoming 6-month period beginning August 1, 2025 shall be the Canterbury Basic default energy rate, which will add a discretionary fund adder up to 4 mils (4 tenths of one cent) to the lowest cost Granite Basic rate established by Community Power Coalition of NH Board of Directors at its upcoming meeting on June 26, 2025. The Canterbury Basic adder amount shall be the greatest of 1-4 mils, **contingent** on the Canterbury Basic Rate being at least 1 mil lower than the lowest of Unitil and Eversource default rates. ¶

If the new Canterbury Basic rate cannot be both lower than the Eversource and Unitil energy service default rates and higher than the Granite Basic Rate established by the CPCNH Board on June 26, then the new 6-month rate for Canterbury Community Power default energy service customers will be the new 6-month Granite Basic Rate as established by the CPCNH Board on June 26, and the Canterbury Basic Rate with the 2-mil adder will be available as an opt-up opportunity for customers who wish to support the adder. ¶
